

## DIRECTIVE TO ACCREDITED CERTIFICATION BODIES AND RESPONSIBLE WOOD CERTIFICATE HOLDERS

Re: Extended Moratorium on the Use/Acceptance of Genetically Modified Forest Based Organisms

## **Background**

This amendment extends the policy on the exclusion of genetically modified forest based organisms under the PEFC system to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022.

The Board of the Responsible Wood, likewise endorsed this extension for operations under the Responsible Wood Certification Scheme.

## **Action required by Certification Bodies and Certificate Holders**

All Certification Bodies and Responsible Wood Certificate Holders are to consider the policy on the exclusion of genetically modified organisms listed in Clause 3 (Terms and Definitions) of AS 4707 Chain of Custody for Forest Products under "Controversial Sources", extended to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022.
