# Certification is a two-part process:

### **Forest certification**

assures that forests are conserved and managed responsibly to ensure they deliver social, environmental and economic benefits now and in the future, balancing people, planet and profit.

### **Chain of Custody certification**

is a verified mechanism for tracking certified materials from the sustainably managed forest to the final product.

Certification is awarded after independent audits verify that the forest management practices and the chain of custody systems are compliant with Responsible Wood's internationally-recognised Australian Standards.®

# Why Responsible Wood?

Responsible Wood is endorsed by the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC), the global authority on sustainable forest management.

## High standards set by the PEFC include requirements to:

- Safeguard ecologically important forest areas
- Protect and enhance biological diversity
- Prohibit deforestation
- Prohibit forest conversions
- Prohibit the most dangerous chemicals
- Prohibit genetically modified trees
- Respect rights of workers and indigenous peoples'
- Encourage local employment
- Provide consultation with local people and stakeholders
- Respect traditional land rights and local customs
- Provide a voice for those who depend on forest for their livelihood.
